Descriptions provided for ICD-10-CM and CPT<sup>®</sup> codes are taken from the American Medical Association *ICD-10-CM* 2025: The Complete Official Codebook, and the IPHA Billing Manual for HIV Testing and Related Services. This information may be a resource when providing HIV and other STI prevention and diagnostic services, and when submitting insurance claims\* for reimbursement for these important services.
